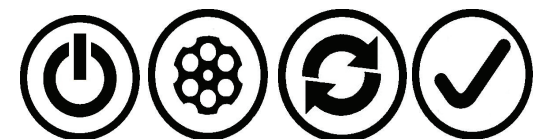
Unless the motion to be reconsidered in not debatable.
